- Two 20-something Dubliners set sail from Newfoundland, Canada to Cork on June 13th in a small two-person rowing vessel to break a world record for non-stop rowing across the Atlantic. They were just 300 km off the coast of Cork when their boat capsized. The Irish Coast Guard rescued them, but only because of the yellow life jackets the two had bought special for this voyage. Needless to say the old record still stands.
- Ali Charaf Damache, an Algerian born Irish citizen with a last known address in Waterford, was arrested in Spain and extradited to the US in July. He is the first foreign terror suspect brought to the U.S. to face charges under the Trump administration.
